

Donor Bill of Rights Statement

As a Non-Governmental Organization (NGO), we believe that donation is a voluntary act and that giving and sharing improve the quality of life. We stand behind and support donor rights as we attach importance to ensuring that NGOs and their projects earn the trust and respect of the public, and that donors and potential donors make safe and smart donations. We acknowledge that all donors have the following rights:

1. To be informed about the mission and vision of the NGO, how the donation will be used and the capacity and intention to use it efficiently in line with the donation purposes.
2. To receive information about the board of directors and managers and to expect managers to perform their duties prudently.
3. Access to up-to-date financial information.
4. To request a guarantee that the donation will be used for its intended purpose.
5. To receive appropriate thanking.
6. To request the confidentiality of donations in accordance with the laws.
7. To request that their relationship with all employees representing the institution maintain a level of professionalism.
8. To know whether the person requesting the donation on behalf of the NGO is a volunteer, an employee or a independent entity contracted for this task.
9. To request their contact information to be removed from the contact lists if these list are to be shared with other entities.
10. To ask questions and to receive immediate, correct and clear answers during the donation process.
